

ATWATER BOMBERS FALL BASEBALL 2025 T-BALL DIVISION GROUND RULES

The major difference in Tee-Ball play concerns winning / losing and what constitutes an inning.

Tee-ball is a learning experience, where **the score is not the focus of the game.**

- 1) The players' ages are from five (5) to seven (7).
- 2) Players must wear team baseball caps and t-shirts. Baseball pants and cleats are optional. Metal cleats are not allowed.
- 3) Three (3) defensive coaches are allowed on the field.
- 4) Two (2) offensive base coaches and one (1) coach for the batter are allowed on the field.
- 5) 50 feet between the bases.
- 6) A full inning is over when all the players on both teams have batted once.
- 7) Each player will play in the field.
- 8) The batter hits the ball off a batting tee; there is no pitching.
- 9) There are no walks or strikeouts.
- 10) No stealing. Runners must stay on the base until the ball is hit.
- 11) A standard game is four (4) innings with a maximum playing time of one (1) hour.
- 12) Scores are not kept in Tee-Ball.
- 13) Batters and base runners must wear safety helmets.
- 14) Bats – 24"/26" long. 2¼" diameter, max. 17 to 20 ounces.
- 15) Athletic footwear may be worn. No metal cleats.
